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ESSENTIAL INFORMATION ABOUT ENTRANCE EXAMINATION

Eligibility Conditions and Qualifications required for Polytechnic (Engineering) Course (PE)

● Educational

Course : Engineering (3 years)

Educational Qualifications : Must have passed the secondary examination conducted by Bihar Vidyalaya Examination Committee or equivalent 10th examination with 35% marks.

● Residential/Domicile

Only those candidates can be admitted who are citizens of India and fall in atleast in one of the following categories :

- (i) Whose parents/husband/wife are the original inhabitants (Natives) of Bihar.
- (ii) Whose parents/husband/wife are the registered refugees in Bihar.
- (iii) Whose parents/husband/wife are the employees of the Bihar Government.
- (iv) Whose parents/husband/wife are central government employees posted in Bihar or are the employees of the Public Sector undertakings situated in Bihar and run by the Government of India.
- (v) Whose parents/husband/wife are employees of the UNO and are posted in Bihar.

● Physical

The applicants selected for admission will have to pass through medical test. They will be admitted only on being found medically fit. Separate fee will have to be paid for medical test.

● Age

No maximum or minimum age limit for applicants has been prescribed for Engineering Course.

● Question-Paper : Engineering Course (PE) and Part Time 4 years Polytechnic Engineering Course (PPE)

Duration : 2 hrs. 15 Minutes
